



HOW TO SUPER FOR WAX PRODUCTION

1. Inspect the colony, ensuring that there are 6 frames covered in bees, counted by observing the bottom bars of the frames. This will ensure there are enough bees to fill both cavities after supering.








2. Supering Rules:

- 1. Never break up open brood. Always ensure that open brood is kept together for heat and nutritional requirements
- 2. Open Brood Up. Heat rises and it decreases the risk of chilled brood
- 3. Consolidate capped brood directly below open brood so the cluster remains intact between chambers



3. Checkerboard the outer-frames placing at least one pollen and honey frame nearest the open brood, while the remaining foundation/less frames around the brood.

Avoid 2 new foundation/less frames side by side if possible.
